




Thank you to everyone who attended the Spring Meeting at Timmer's on April 30th. It was great to see a few new faces and get to know more about our chapter members.

SAFETY AND REGISTRATION: State Registration documents on board with proper numbers on your boat. One PFD for each person onboard plus one throwable. One orange flag plus Flares (check the expiration date). One Fire Extinguisher for boats with inboards. A horn or other sound producing device. Flame arrestors for gasoline engine boats built after April 25,1940. Blowers are required for gasoline engine boats built after July 31,1980. Navigation lights for after sunset. I would like to stress that the no wake rule is in effect in all areas of the inner harbor, all the rivers, and the breakwater exits to the open lake.
